It's Good to be Green system encourages and rewards children for positive behaviour.



CROMER ROAD GOLDEN RULES

- ☺ We are honest
- ☺ We are kind and helpful
- ☺ We are polite and respectful
 - ☺ We are gentle
 - ☺ We listen
- ☺ We follow instructions
 - ☺ We work hard
- ☺ We look after property

If children break a Golden Rule:

- They are given a verbal reminder.
- If the behaviour continues they are given a warning and their card is turned on its side as a visual reminder to improve the behaviour.
- If the behaviour still continues, their card is turned to Orange and the children miss 5 minutes of their playtime.
- During the term if a child's card is turned to Orange on 3 occasions they will not qualify for the school 'It's Good to be Green' termly award and parents will be informed.
- If the card is at Orange and the behaviour persists their card is turned to Red. This means that the child will not qualify for the school 'It's Good to be Green' termly award and parents will be informed. In addition children will spend 30 minutes in the Reflection room at lunchtime.
- If it is a major incident (any incident involving inappropriate physical contact such as; fighting, hitting, kicking, biting, spitting at someone) their card is turned immediately to Red. An appropriate sanction will be decided by at least two members of senior staff and parents will be informed.
- All teachers keep weekly records of children who remain on 'Green'.

Some children with particular needs will have their own behaviour plan and may not follow the It's Good to be Green system.
