**Hairstyles must meet with the standards of smartness and restraint expected in a school**  
**Simple, plain navy hair band, grip or 'scrunchy' – no other coloured decorative hair adornments**  
**No denim or leather jackets, 'hoodies' or sports tops**  
**No make-up or nail varnish**

**No jewellery whatsoever, including ear studs & other piercings**

In the event that an item of jewellery is required for reasons of religious observance a letter will be required from the appropriate authority to explain the necessity for this requirement

**No mobile phones or other mobile communication/entertainment devices visible or audible during the school day**

If there is an unavoidable reason why you feel your child must have a mobile phone with them on the journey to and from school, then you should place it in a clear plastic bag with the child's name clearly

marked on the bag and it should be handed in to the school office at the start of the day and collected at the end of the day. A student found to have a mobile phone at school during the school day will have it removed immediately and the parent/s will be asked to collect the phone from the school office.

**Please note that in light of this rule the school will not accept responsibility for the loss, theft or damage to a mobile phone brought to school and will not investigate any such loss, theft or damage should it occur.**

### **SIXTH FORM**

Students in the Sixth Form are required to dress smartly to the standard required by a professional place of employment such as a bank. Clothing should be neat and simple in style and jewellery should be unobtrusive. Boys are required to wear a jacket and tie and these are to be worn in and around school. Girls are required to wear a smart skirt or trousers with blouse and jacket. All clothing should be of a suitably restrained colour and style. Smart suits are particularly recommended.

Sixth Form students may bring a mobile phone to school but are expected to use them responsibly - mobile phones and other mobile entertainment devices should not be used, visible or audible in school corridors, classrooms, or in lessons.
