MUSIC8LONDON

The Camden Music Service and Hub is part of MUSIC8LONDON, group of Hubs whose other members are Barnet, Brent, Ealing, Enfield, Haringey, Harrow and Hillingdon.

In June 2013 the North London group were awarded an Arts Council Catalyst Arts grant to build fundraising capacity across the area. The grant extended over 2 years with the Barnet Education Arts Trust taking the role of lead organisation for the project.

Since June 2015 the members of MUSIC8LONDON continue to work together with a revolving lead organisation, currently the Ealing Music Service.
