### How it works

You probably sing this already. It only uses one chord and as such works in many, many parts. Each bar fits with every other bar and can be used as an ostinato ie repeated throughout the song.

Singing two bar phrases against each other is a good way into part singing eg have a group singing the first bit "Shalom my friend, Shalom my friend", have another group on the second bit "Shalom, Shalom" and a third group singing "Until we meet again my friend"

If you have access to a number of tuned percussion instruments the children could learn to play one or two bar phrases as an accompaniment to the song.
